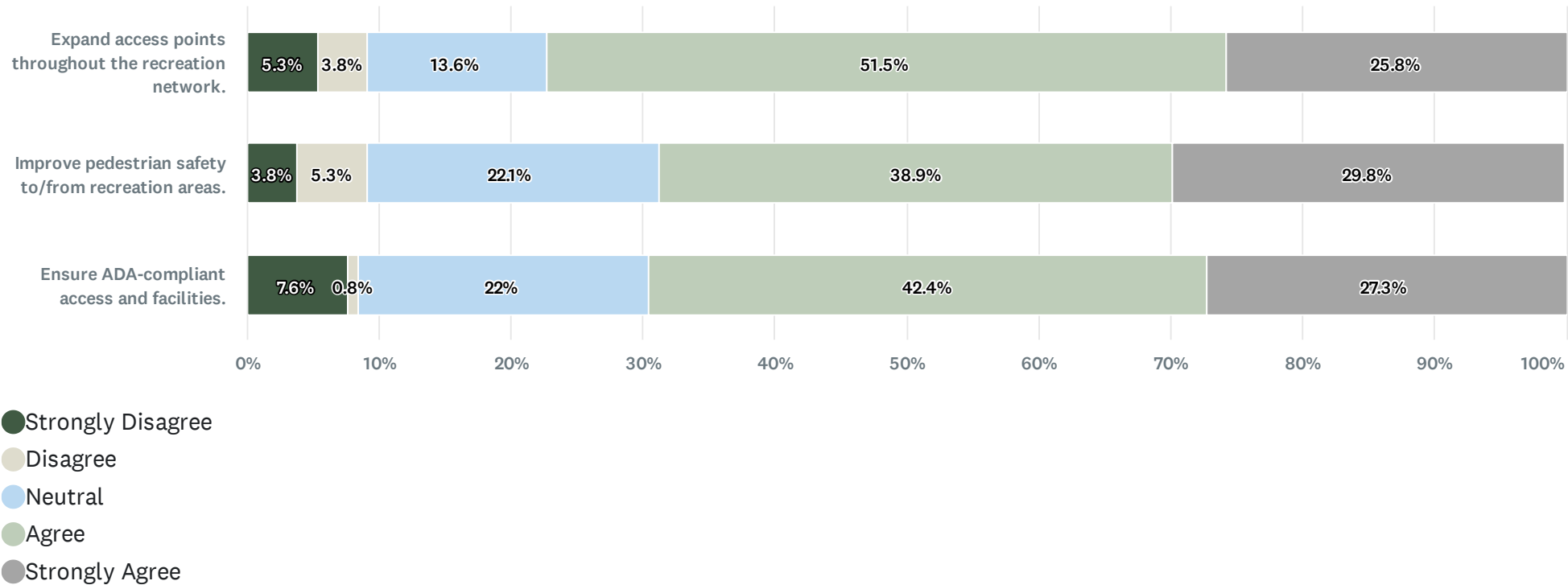

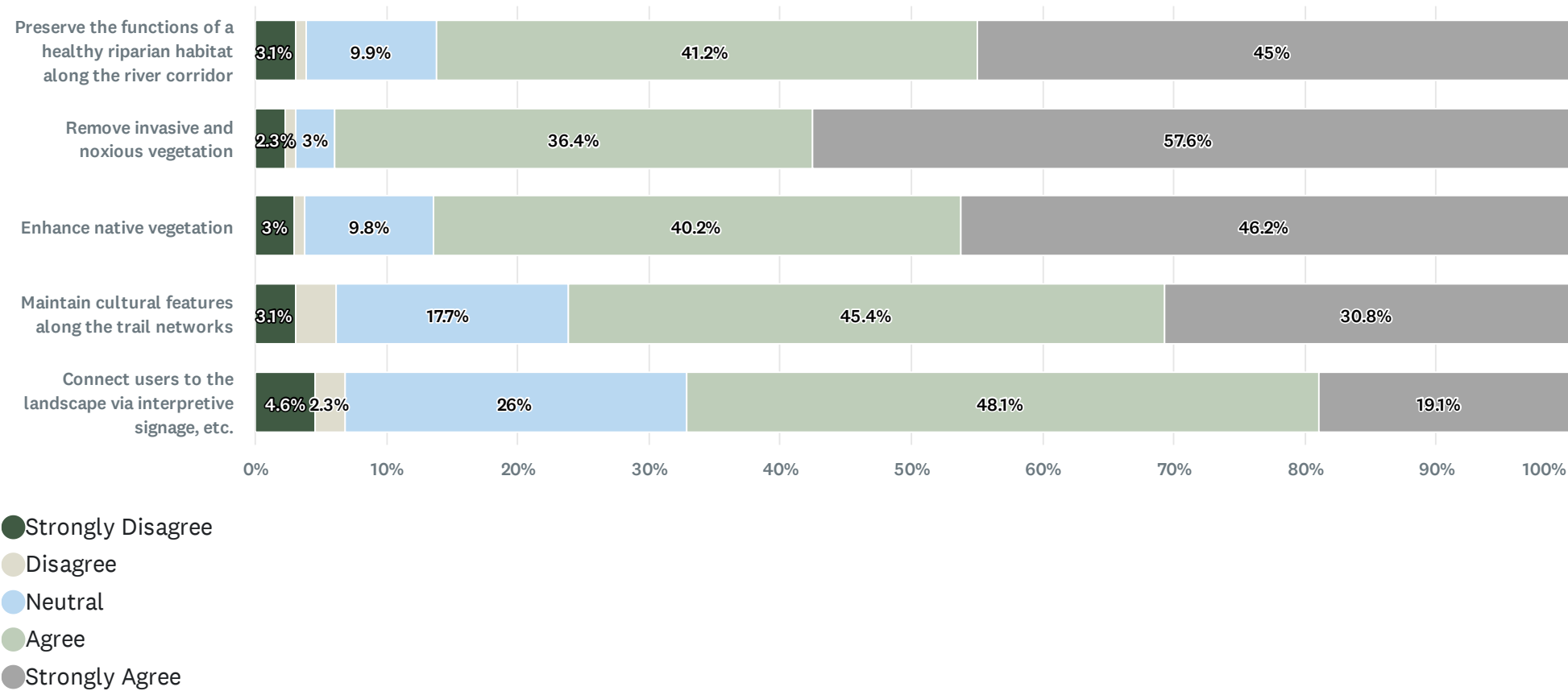

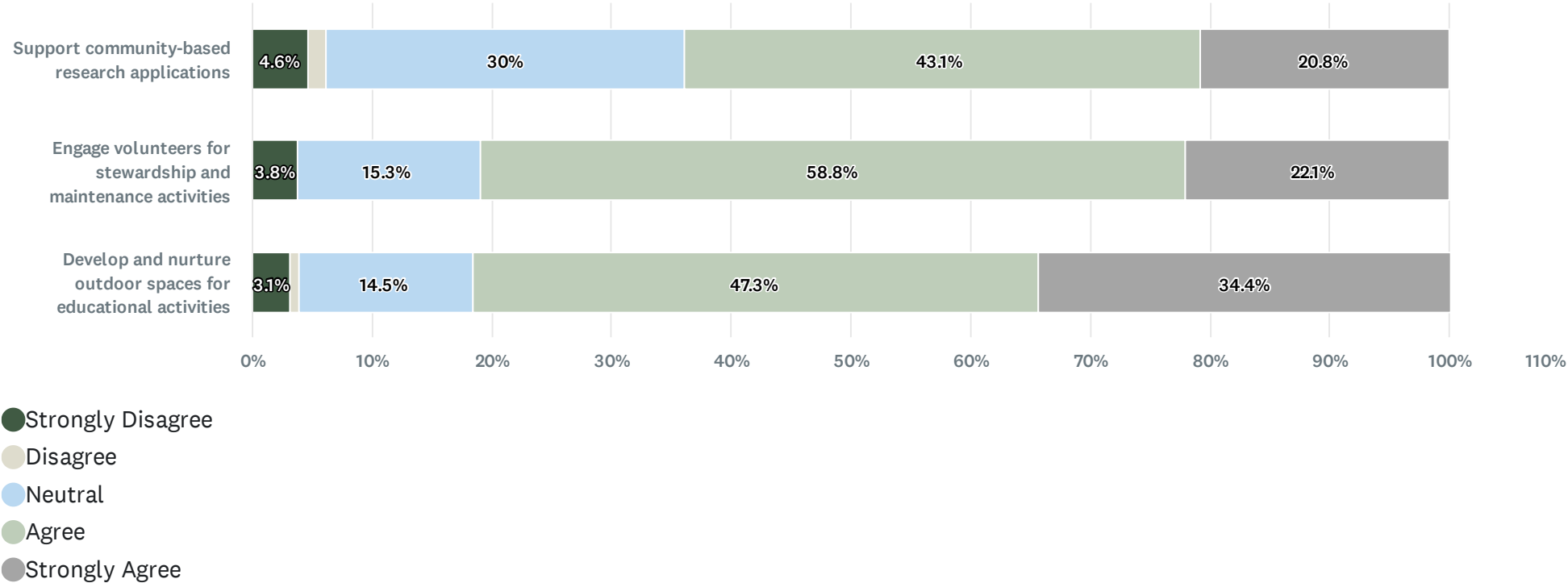

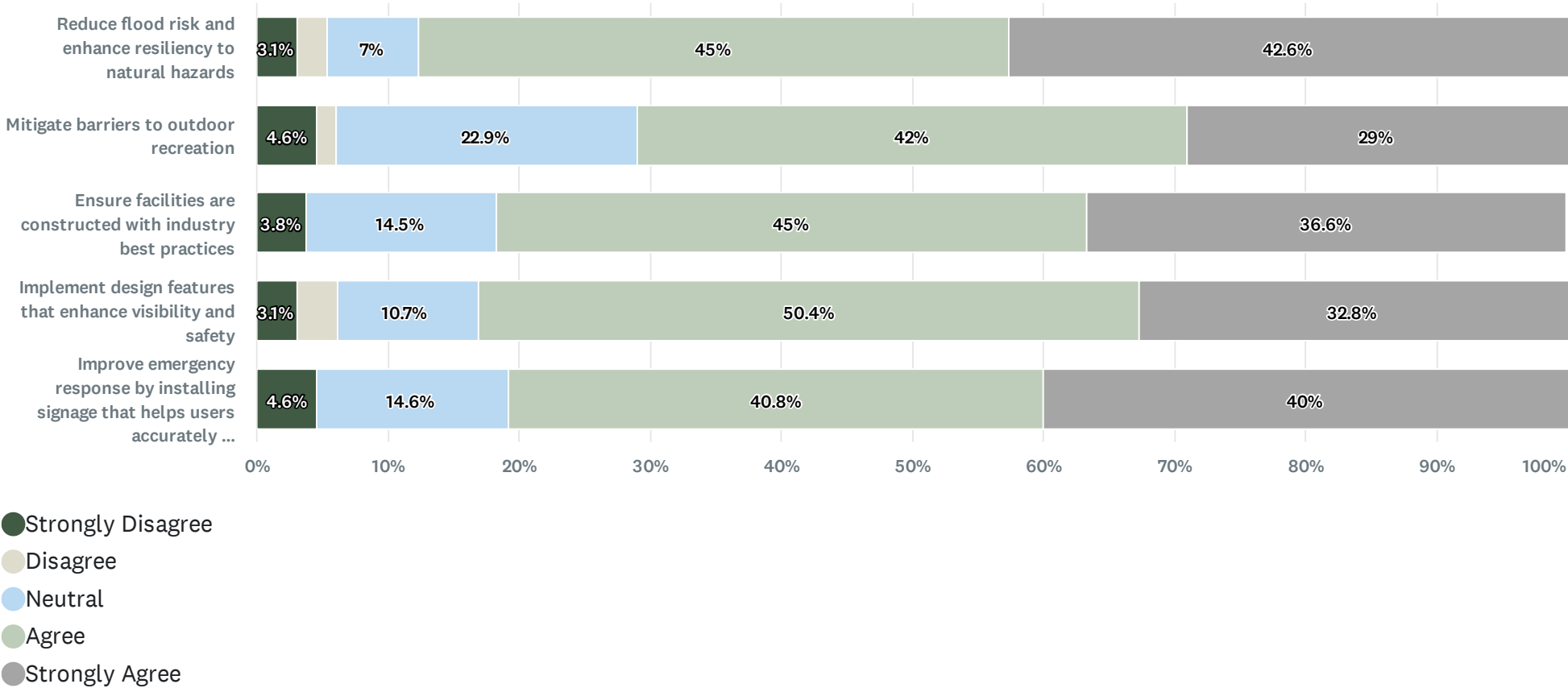

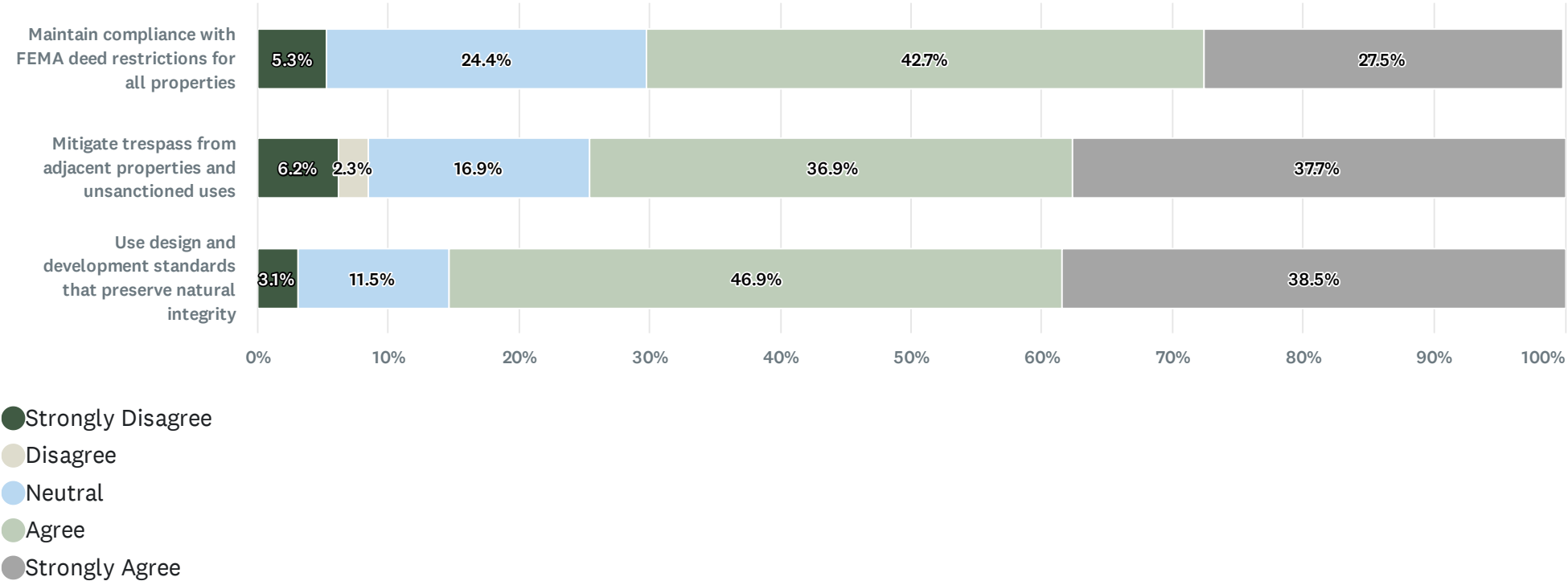

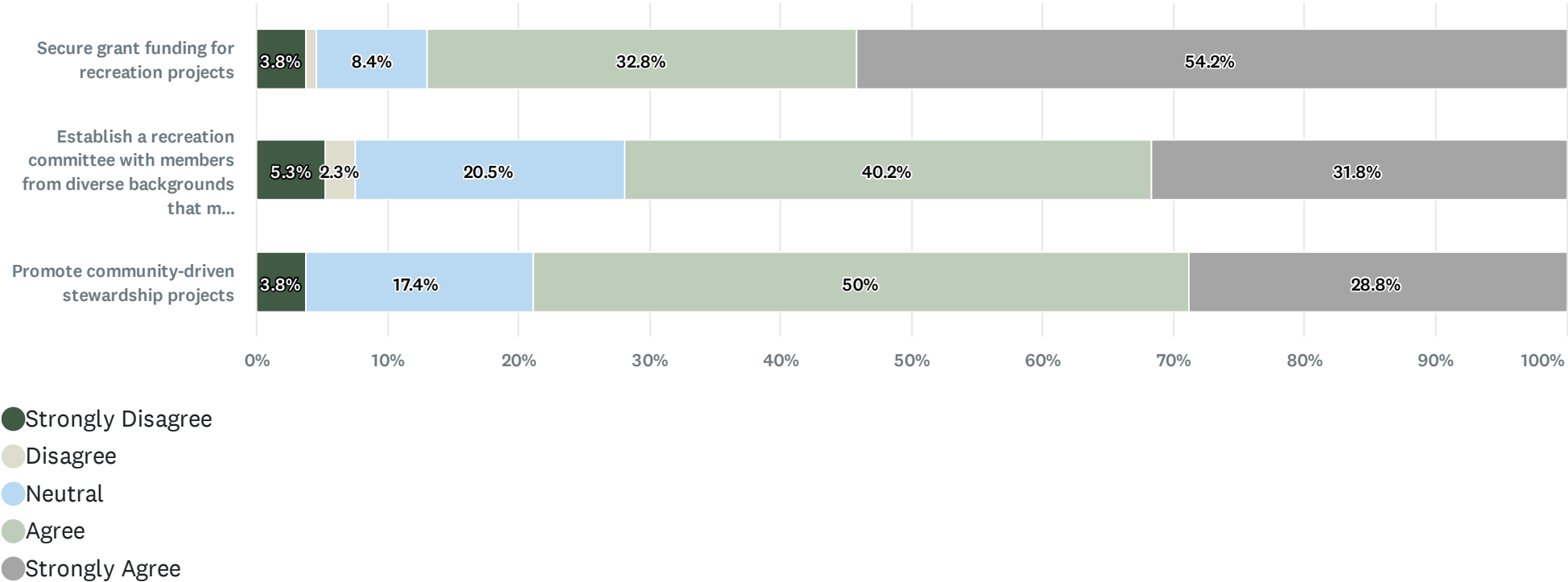

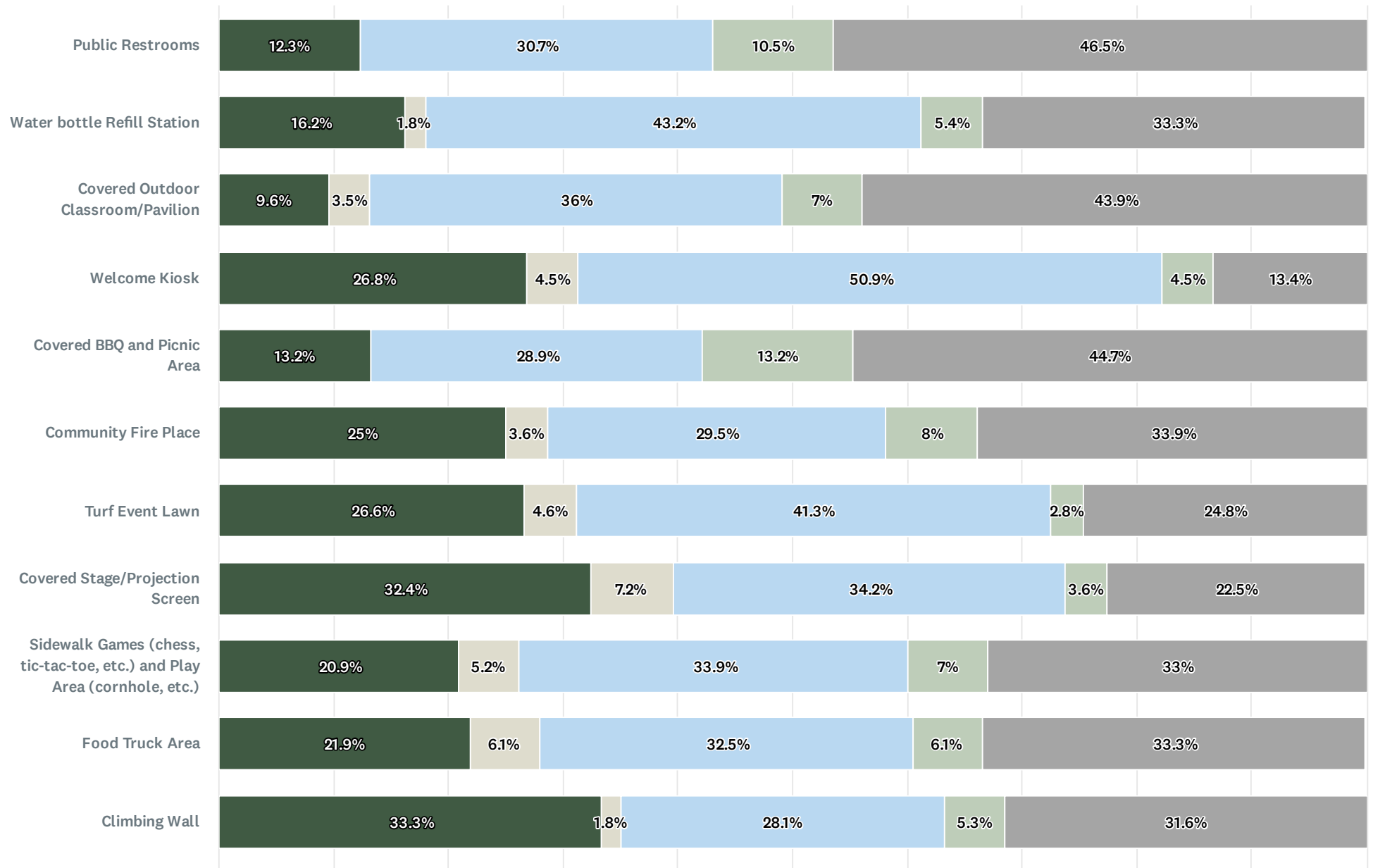

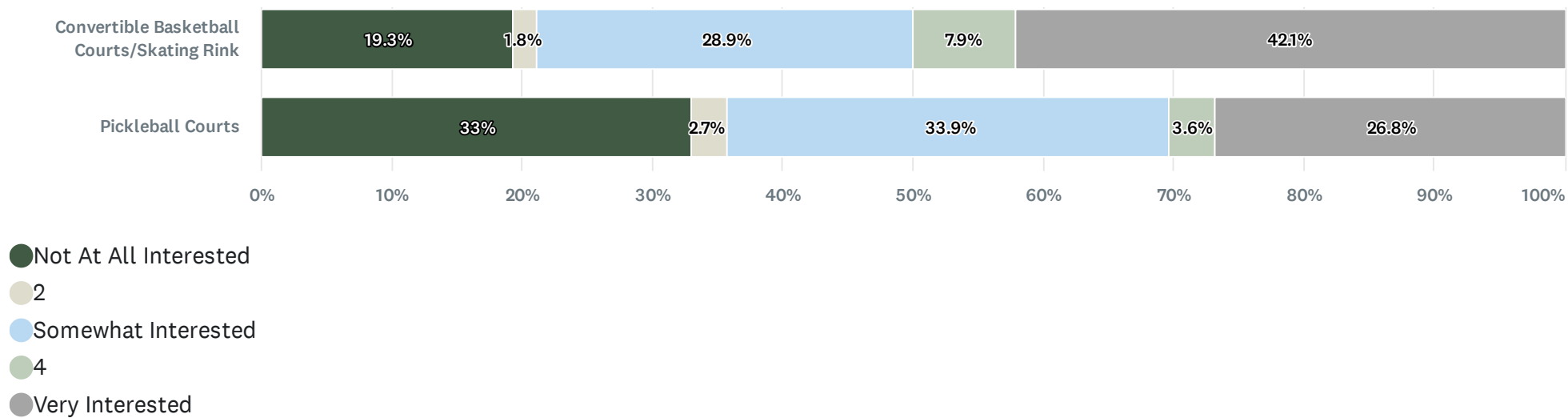

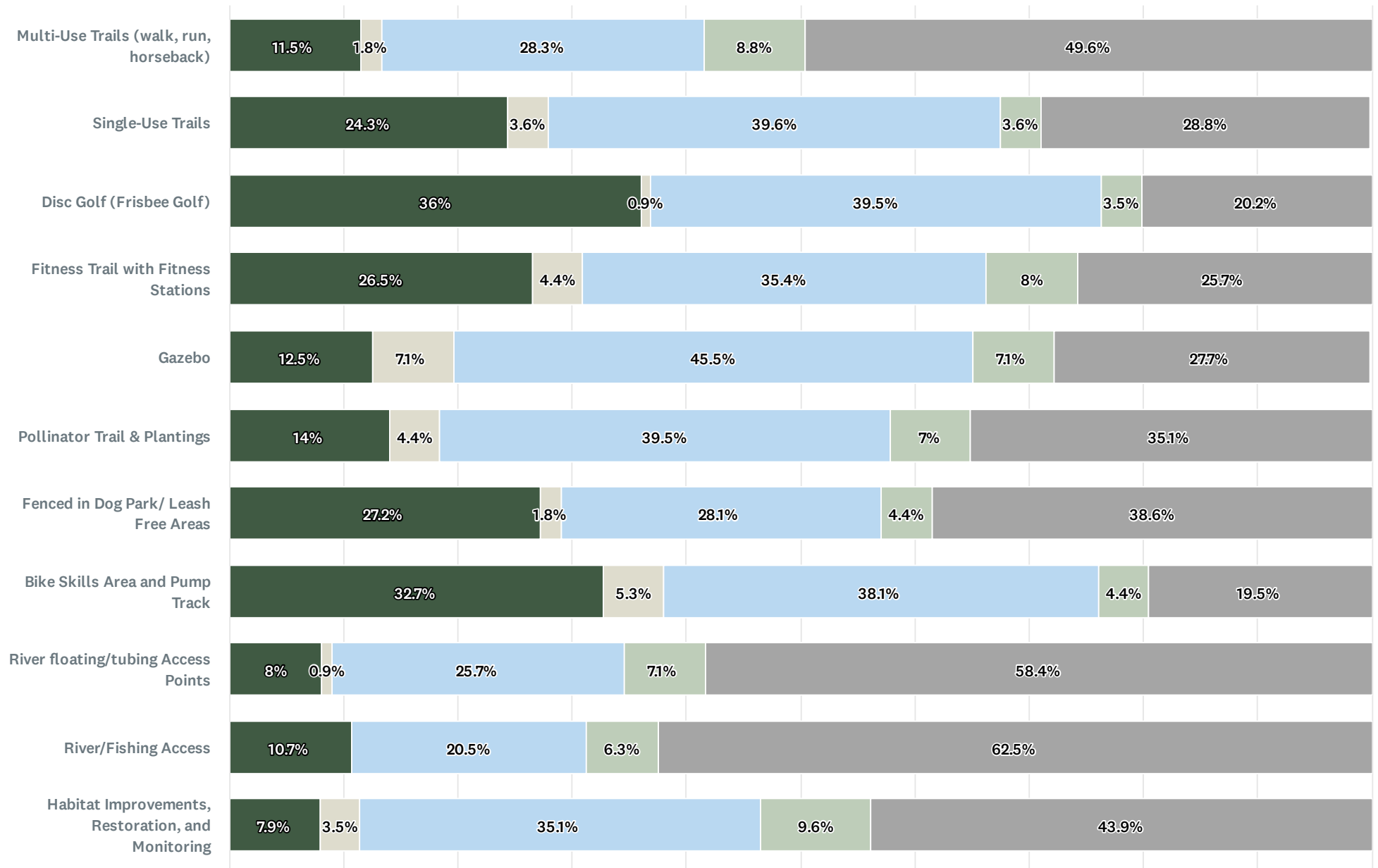

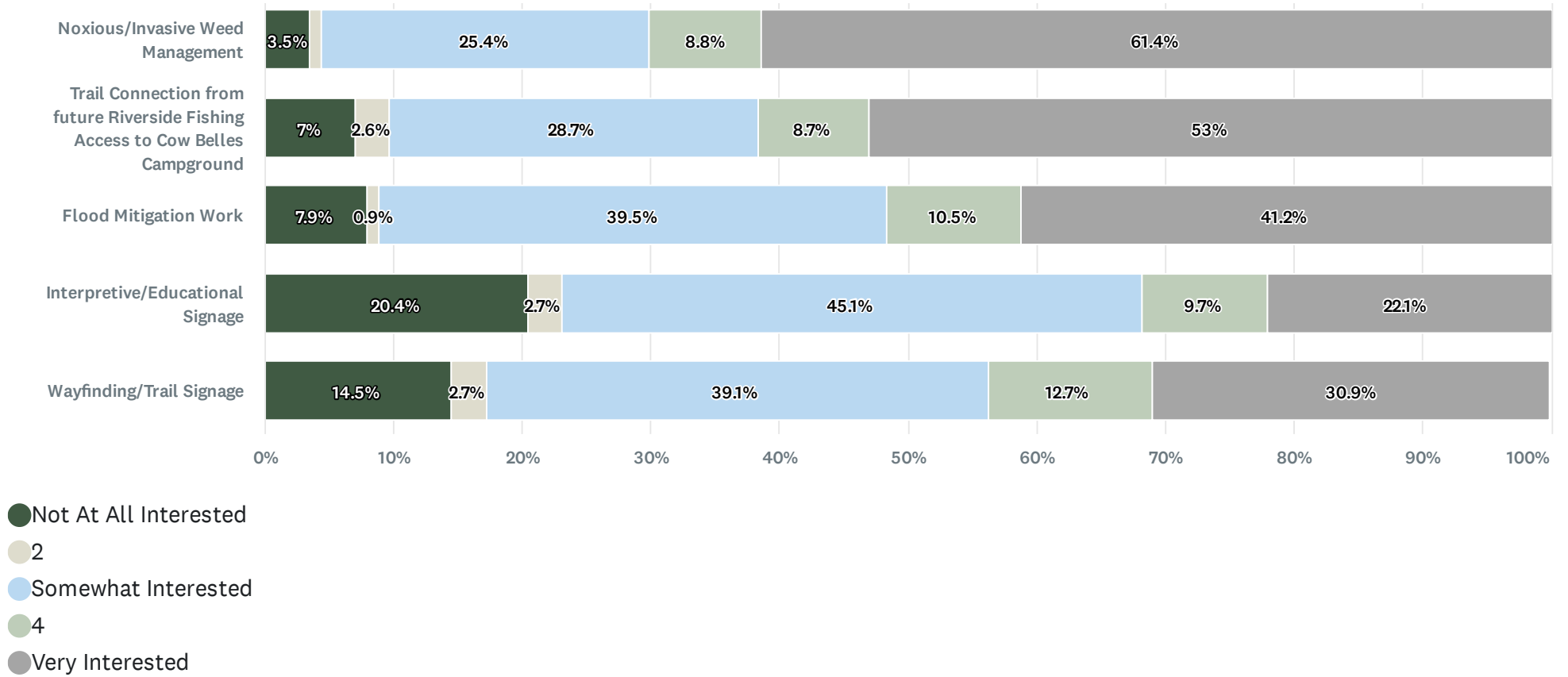

Indicate your interest in the proposed recreation opportunities and facilities throughout Roundup Reach



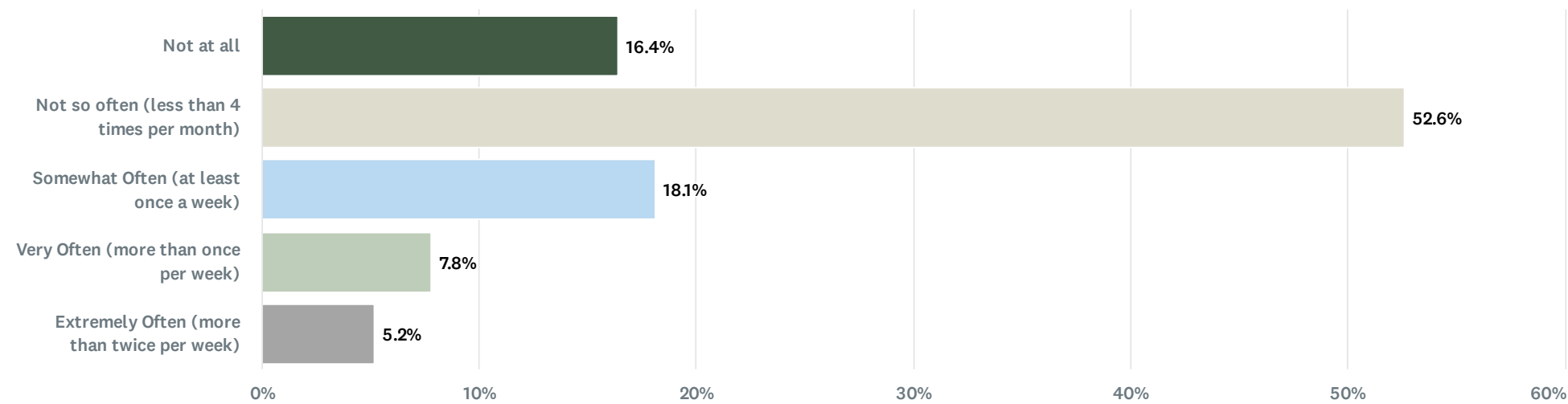

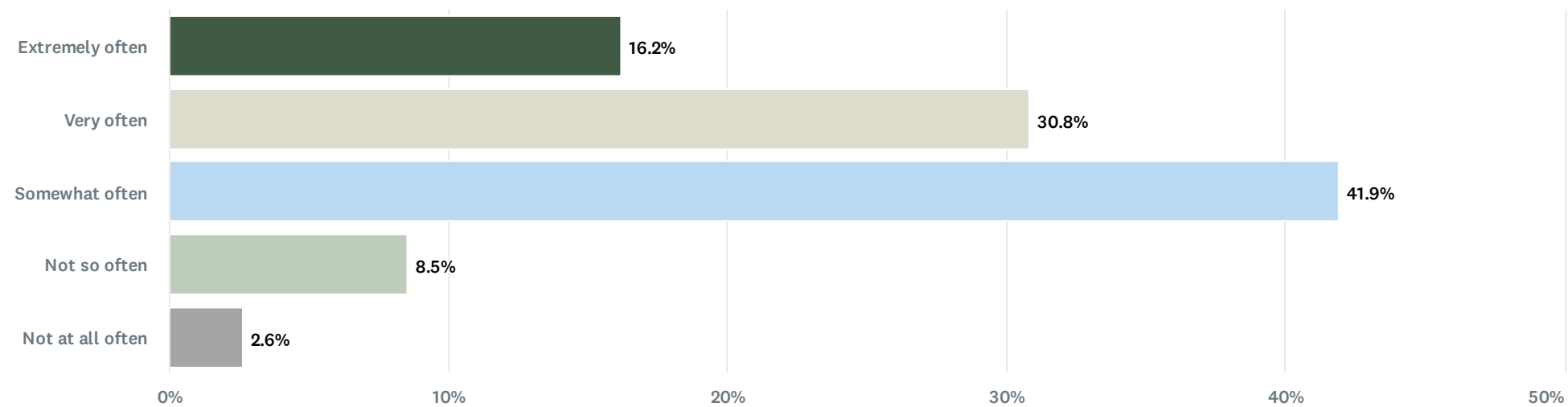

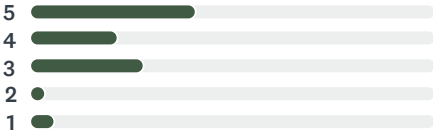
